Amenity of rooms/Key features

All rooms include an electric high-low bed, air-conditioning, access to ensuite, bedside table, over-bed table, built in wardrobe, television connection and contemporary furnishings designed for aged care needs.

Fees and Charges

Depending on your financial situation, your care and accommodation costs may be partly or fully covered by the government. There are three types of fees – daily fee, means tested fees and accommodation payments.

Basic daily fee: This is an amount that everyone pays for day-to-day services they receive at the aged care home. This fee is set at around 85% of the single aged pension and is currently \$63.57 per day. This fee will be adjusted twice a year, along with adjustments to the pension rate.

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Means-tested care fee: A contribution that some people pay towards the cost of their care, determined by a means assessment. Services Australia will work out if you are required to pay this fee based on an assessment of your income and assets and will advise you of the amount.

Accommodation payment: Some people may need to pay an accommodation payment depending on an assessment of income and assets. This is in the form of a lump sum (refundable accommodation deposit) or daily payment (daily accommodation payment) or a combination of both.

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a refundable accommodation deposit (RAD), a daily accommodation payment (DAP), or a combination of both. A RAD is paid as a lump sum amount. A DAP accrues daily and is paid monthly. A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum and daily payments. Additional Services Fee – We offer a list of services that incur an additional fee (e.g. hairdressing, massage therapy) and residents are able to opt in and opt out at any time.
